General Description:

The Town Hall Archives currently consist of 81 boxes (35 linear feet) of material pertaining to the individuals and organizations that utilized the facility from 1921 to 1978. Although the correspondence, programs, photographs and other records cover activities at Town Hall since its opening in 1921, the bulk of the collection is concentrated in the span from 1960 to 1978.

The records are arranged in 7 series as follows. Detailed descriptions precede the folder list for each box. An asterisk (*) indicates gaps in the series:
